The Paul Bunyan Ski Hill is planning a fun-filled event on July 3rd, 2021, and has asked the Paul Bunyan Riders Snowmobile Club to do a meat raffle. It will take place either in the warming tent, or outside under the deck if the weather is favorable.

Their events will start with a **Veterans ATV UTV Ride** that leaves the Ski Hill at 10am, and returns around 2pm. Starting at 2pm Paul Bunyan Riders Snowmobile Club will start the meat raffle.

There will also be a mud bog and obstacle course for ATVs UTVs, as well as one for the Friends of the Forest Jeep Club folks.

Please come and join in the fun with the whole family. Come watch the ATVs and Jeep's make it through the mud, and support our veterans and local snowmobile club at the same time. The cost will be \$10 per person to be in the in the morning ride, and 100 percent will be donated to Post 44 in Wabeno, and to the Wisconsin Veteran Home in King. The cost to the public is free to come and watch the fun.

The Meat Raffle will be from 2pm to 6pm, and will be structured very similar to the 4-hour event we did for the Snow Fun Day. The spin wheel tickets will cost \$2.00 each and our goal will be to have between 30 and 35 spins with 4 winners per ticket (2 first place and 2 second place prizes). The prizes will consist of mostly SuperValu meat, but donated crafts, and gift certificate donations from area businesses will also be accepted. We will mix them in to enhance the value of the prizes. Everything will be on the spin wheel. We will also be doing 50/50 raffles during that time to add to the success of the meat raffle, as well.

In order to make this fundraiser successful we will need the help of our members. Please volunteer to work either of the two shifts. The work shifts will be from 2:00pm to 4:00pm and then 4:00pm to 6:00pm. Please try to come 10 minutes early so there is a smooth transition so the spin wheel keeps going.
